*Steckerlfisch ("steckerl" means "small stick" or "pole" in the Bavarian dialect) is a fish grilled on a stick in the traditional way of a fisherman or camper. It is considered a specialty of Austria and Bavaria. The dish is commonly served in beer garden and on folk festivals and is unrelated to the dried stockfish.*

*Traditionally, Steckerlfisch is prepared from local fish like coregonus or whitefish like common bream, but nowadays trout, char or mackerel are also used.*
